National Economic Recovery (PEN) Non-fiscal incentives towards National Logistic Ecosystem

President Joko Widodo (Jokowi) issued Presidential Instruction (Inpres) Number 5 of Year 2020 concerning National Logistics Ecosystem Structuring. Specifically addressed to the Minister of Indonesia Moves Forward Cabinet, Cabinet Secretary, Chief of Police, Heads of Non-Ministerial Government Institutions, and Governors throughout Indonesia.

This Presidential Instruction was issued by the President to improve national logistics performance, improve the investment climate, and increase the competitiveness of the national economy. This presidential Instruction becomes an incentive of non-fiscal form by the government as an effort to national recovery Economics (PEN). The aims are to ease the logistics processes of the business in Indonesia with INSW (Indonesia National Single Window) system.

INSW is the Indonesian national system that supports the single submission of data and information, single and synchronous processing of data and information, and single decision making to present customs, single decision making for customs clearance, and release of cargoes. The implementation of INSW includes licensing, export-import, logistics, ports, distribution of goods, business processes, and payment transactions.
