## **President Joko Widodo Revoked the Presidential Decree No. 10 Year 2021 on Attachment III related to Alcohol Investment**

President Joko Widodo (Jokowi) withdrew the Attachment III of the Presidential Decree No. 10 Year 2021 on March 2<sup>nd</sup> 2021 which regulates the opening of new investments in the alcohol-containing alcoholic beverage industry which stated in the virtual press release in the YouTube video of the Presidential Secretariat: "I hereby convey, I decide on the attachment to the Presidential Decree regarding the opening of new investment in the liquor industry which contains alcohol, I declare it to be revoked."

According to Jokowi, this decision was taken after receiving input from various religious community organizations, public figures, and other provincial governments. "After receiving input from MUI Ulama, Nahdlatul Ulama NU, Muhammadiyah and other mass organizations, as well as other religious figures, as well as inputs from provinces and regions," said Jokowi.

The rules regarding investment related to liquor are contained in Attachment III of the Presidential Decree concerning a list of business fields with certain requirements. The following is a list of business fields regarding alcoholic beverages and their requirements:

1. Line of business: liquor industry contains alcohol  
Requirements:
  - a. New investment can be made in Bali Province, East Nusa Tenggara Province, North Sulawesi Province, and Papua Province by consideration of local culture.
  - b. Investment other than letter **a**, can be determined by the Head of the Investment Coordinating Board based on the governor's recommendation.
  
2. Line of business: alcoholic beverage (wine) industry  
Requirements:
  - a. New investment can be made in Bali Province, East Nusa Tenggara Province, North Sulawesi Province, and Papua Province by consideration of local culture.
  - b. Investment other than letter **a**, can be determined by the Head of the Investment Coordinating Board based on the governor's recommendation.
  
3. Line of business: beverage industry containing malt  
Requirements:
  - a. New investment can be made in Bali Province, East Nusa Tenggara Province, North Sulawesi Province, and Papua Province by consideration of local culture.

- b. Investment other than letter a, can be determined by the Head of the Investment Coordinating Board based on the governor's recommendation.
4. Line of business: retail trade of liquor or alcohol  
Requirements: Distribution network and special place.
5. Line of business: street retail trade of liquor or alcohol  
Requirements: Distribution network and special place.
